New, simplified payroll reporting

Some of our policyholders had a suggestion: Simplify the payroll reporting system. We took the suggestion seriously and have designed new payroll reporting forms and a less complicated reporting system.

Our policyholders now will only have to report payroll for a period of time requested. The policyholders will no longer have to calculate their premium and send payment. Instead, we will do the calculations based on the figures provided in our new reports and then send a statement with the amount due.

In this newsletter, we would like to provide you with a guide to the new reporting forms.

Payroll Report

- 1 Payroll Report Due Date:** Your report should be in our office no later than the due date to avoid initiation of the cancellation policy.
- 2 Contacts:** If your policy was written through an insurance agent, your agent's name and phone number will be here. Also, the Fund underwriter who handles your policy will be shown here.
- 3 New phone number:** The Fund has a new telephone system, and your underwriter's new phone number is a direct line to his or her desk. See article on back page.
- 4 Reporting period:** Please tell us how much payroll you paid during the time period indicated. In this example, the time period is November 1999.
- 5 Class Code:** Here you will find the class codes applied to your policy, descriptions of the codes, and the rates per \$100 payroll for the codes.
- 6 Report payroll here:** Please fill in the blank lines with the payroll amount you paid for each class code during the payroll reporting period.
- 7 Reporting reminders:** Remember, you don't have to report the overtime hourly wage paid, just the straight time amount. For example, if Employee A's regular hourly wage is \$10 and he works 50 hours, with 10

- 2 Contacts:** If your policy was written through an insurance agent, your agent's name and phone number will be here. Also, the name of the Fund underwriter who handles your policy will be shown here.
- 3 New phone number:** The Fund has a new telephone system, and your underwriter's new phone number is a direct line to his or her desk. See article on back page.
- 4 Reporting period:** The purpose of the renewal payroll report is to tally the payroll for the entire policy year to determine the final premium. In this example, the policy year ran from Oct. 1, 1998 to October 1, 1999.
- 5 Class Code:** Here you will find the class codes applied to your policy, descriptions of the codes, and the rates per \$100 payroll for the codes.
- 6 Year-To-Date Billed Payroll:** The numbers in this column will reflect the total that has been billed as of the "Issue Date" of this report. The "Issue Date" is shown in the upper righthand corner. In this example, the report was issued Dec. 17, 1999. NOTE: Policyholders using the Level Pay Plan, or "stipulated" plan, will not see any numbers here.
- 7 Total Yearly Payroll:** The Total Yearly Payroll equals YTD Billed Payroll plus any payroll that has been paid since the YTD Billed Payroll period, which in most cases would be payroll paid during the final reporting period. For example, a policyholder with a quarterly reporting policy would add payroll paid during the fourth quarter of the policy year to the YTD Billed Payroll figure to determine the amount to fill in the Total Yearly Payroll column. NOTE: The amount you write in this column should also include any payments you made to uninsured contractors and subcontractors and for contract labor and piece work. See information below about Page 2 of the Renewal Payroll Report.
- 8 Reporting reminders:** Remember, you don't have to report the overtime hourly wage paid, just the straight time amount. State Fund issues \$40.6 million dividend

The Idaho State Insurance Fund distributed a \$40.6 million dividend to eligible policyholders in early January.

The dividend was based on the premiums paid and losses incurred for those policies with inception dates between July 1, 1997, and June 30, 1998.

“The expression ‘Safety pays’ may seem like a cliché to some, but our policyholders once again have proven it is a fact,” said James M. Alcorn, manager of the Fund. “Because Idaho’s employers and workers continue to remain focused on workplace safety, the Fund is able to issue a dividend for the 31st year in a row.”

To be eligible to receive a dividend, a policyholder must have been insured for six months and have had a policy effective date between July 1, 1997, and June 30, 1998. The dividend amount received by a policyholder was based on the policyholder’s premium size and loss experience.

Dividends were distributed to 23,008 policyholders.

Overall rate drops 1.7%

Idaho’s overall workers compensation rate fell by an average 1.7 percent for the year 2000, the sixth year in a row that the overall rate has decreased.

Policyholders should be aware that their rates may not reflect exactly a decrease of the average 1.7 percent. Because the 1.7 percent overall rate is an average, some policyholders’ rates may go up, while others may go down.

In addition, the State Insurance Fund filed for, and the Department of Insurance approved, a 13 percent deviation, or across-the-board reduction, for the Fund’s 2000 rates.

The actual premium cost for individual policyholders also is affected by claims experience.

New rates go into effect when a policy is renewed in 2000.

State Insurance Fund 2000 Rates

These rates reflect a 13 percent across-the-board rate reduction, or deviation, approved by the Department of Insurance for the Fund's 2000 rates. The first number in each column indicates the class code, while the number after the description shows the rate per \$100 payroll/remuneration.

If you know the Fund employee's phone number, you won't have to dial the Fund's main number and then dial an extension or wait to be transferred by the reception desk.

The Fund has installed a Direct-In-Dial telephone system. With this new system, most staff members have a new, unique seven-digit telephone number.

This new system should provide you, the caller, with more options and convenience. Besides dialing directly to the Fund employee, you can have the choice of leaving a voice mail message, being placed on hold until the employee is available, or speaking with another Fund team



member, who may be able to assist you.

So, how do you get Fund employees' phone numbers? Look at the documents, such as statements and payroll reporting forms, you receive from us. The name and phone number of a Fund contact will be provided. The numbers also will be available at our web site at www2.state.id.us/isif/, and, if you have regular contact with someone at the Fund, you may have

already received the new number from him or her.

Our old number (334-2370) and three-digit extensions will work for a limited time. If you dial the old number, please listen to the automated attendant for instructions. Our fax numbers will not change, and, for the time being, neither will our toll-free number.
